To Feedyards in the Beef Empire:

The 2023 Beef Empire Days Cattle Working Contest will use the new structure as in 2022! This will allow competing teams to be judged in a preliminary which will take place in the comfort of their own processing facilities. The top 6 teams from the preliminaries will be invited to compete in the Grand Finale. All teams desiring to participate will have to pre-enroll. The pre-enrollment period will be open February 1 — March 31st. The entry fee is \$50 per team. The Grand Finale will be held on Thursday June 8th, at 10:00 a.m. at a location to be announced. Lunch will be served at Noon after the competition.

Preliminaries and Grand Finale will have the same structure:

A judge will contact the enrolled team to schedule the preliminary. The judge will travel to the participating teams home processing facility. Each team shall consist of 4 members. At least two original team members during preliminary must be present to compete in the Grand Finale. Each team will perform an initial/arrival process on a minimum of 40 head. The team will be judged on animal handling, facilities & equipment, implanting, vaccinating, and deworming. Before each animal is released from the chute, judges will evaluate technique and product administration. If problems are detected, the judges will discuss these with the team members before the animal is released from the chute. This is a timed event, but judging is based on quality of work, time will only be used in the event of a tiebreaker.

Grand Finale: At the conclusion of the event the first and second place teams will be announced and awarded. First and second place teams are invited to the Awards Banquet on Friday, June 9th where they will be recognized. Tickets for the banquet will be provided.
